

Camel's Backstage Studio Information 2023 - 2024

Uniform Dance Attire must be worn at all times!!

Beginner Dance Uniform - (3yr, 4yr, Pre-K, Kindergarten Grade Students) black skirt leotard with white or pink tights, black ballets, and black taps.

Intermediate Dance Uniform-(1st and 2nd Grade Students) black Backstage uniform top and black uniform skort, white socks, black taps and black ballets.

Junior Advanced Dance Uniform (3rd, 4th, 5th & 6th Grade Students) black Uniform top and black leggings, black taps and black jazz shoes

Advanced Dance Uniform- (6th, 7th, 8th, 9th) black uniform top, black jazz pants, leggings, black jazz shoes, black taps.

A Dressing room is available for students who are exiting or entering from other activities; dance uniform is always required. Hair must be tied away from the face. No jewelry will be worn for class. Lessons begin on time. Please be prompt. Disruptive students will be asked not to participate in dance class and parents will be notified.

All students are expected to participate in **one** recital dance routine. Special routines will be considered after six years of dance training. All routines, music, and costumes will be chosen by the teacher. Students who withdraw before the recital date are responsible for full costume payment.

Twelve year graduating students must earn 25 student teaching hours and four years of dance training with Camel's Backstage Studio. Dance Study Awards and Perfect Attendance Awards begin on the first day of class. All Awards end at recital time. Perfect Attendance Awards will be awarded to any student who dresses out and works out each class without absences. Dance Training Awards will be awarded to students who complete three years of training, six years of training, and each additional year following the sixth year.

Receipts will be given for cash payments only. Checks for payments are preferred.

Dance School Closures will follow the public school system holiday schedule. Classes will be held on parent conference days.

Observers Day will be scheduled in March or April, the date will be sent by newsletter.
